CRITERIA FOR FUNDING

*Funding is done in accordance with our Mission Statement and the Annual Focus

Mission

The Attic Angel Association is a not-for-profit, independent organization of volunteers who improve the quality of life within Dane County. Members meet health and human Service needs through volunteer and financial support, with special concern for children and the elderly. A major focus is Attic Angel Community, which provides living and health care options for older adults.

1. For the year 2024/25, only programs that are in accordance with our Annual Focus will be funded:
“FOR COLLABORATIVE EFFORTS TO PREVENT HOUSING INSECURITY FOR FAMILIES WITH CHILDREN”
2. The request should meet health and human service needs.
3. A valid need exists that must be addressed.
4. No other agency is providing the service or the need is greater than the service available.
5. The agency is unable to get adequate funding elsewhere.
6. The agency has submitted a proposal in accordance with the Attic Angel Association guidelines.

Attic Angel Policies

- ◆ *Only requests for specific programs or capital projects are considered (2002)*
- ◆ *The Association will not fund more than half the operating budget of an existing organization. (1993)*
- ◆ *Funds not used in accordance with the grant application must be returned. (2017)*
- ◆ *An agency may not receive funding for the same program for more than three consecutive years (2001)*
- ◆ *The Association shall not assist in the fundraising efforts of other organizations unless specifically approved by the Board of Directors. (1968)*
- ◆ *The Outreach Committee will monitor Board approved projects that require volunteer effort and will also recommend to the Board expenditures of any funds (designated annually by the Board) to support activities of other organizations in Dane County (1974)*
